

Workshop on Management of Behavior Disorders

On 22nd June, 2019 a workshop was organized by the Department of Psychology on 'Management of Behavior Disorders' in the Central hall of the college. The resource person for the event was Shalini Anant, Assistant Professor of TISS, Mumbai. It was a one-day workshop in which 55 participants were present.
